

## 24,00 MW Kleinwasserkraft mit 3x Francis-Turbine





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Brasilien ist gemessen an der installierten Kapazität der zweitgrößte Wasserkrafterzeuger der Welt und verfügt mit 60 Prozent der Gesamtkapazität des Kontinents über die größte installierte Wasserkraftkapazität in Südamerika.

Große Wasserkraft ist nach wie vor die wichtigste Quelle für die Stromversorgung, während Wind- und Sonnenenergie etwa 11 Prozent ausmachen.

Dieses Kraftwerk befindet sich in der Gemeinde Rio dos Cedros, im Bundesstaat Santa Catarina, Brasilien.
